
Privacy Protection Policy

Personal Data Administration and Processing

These principles of the personal data protection described below (together with our contractual conditions) determine the conditions under which ORGREZ a.s. uses and protects all the personal data and other information related thereto which you provide to it when using its web pages. ORGREZ a.s. is obliged to protect your privacy including your personal data and undertakes to duly observe this obligation. Any requirements concerning disclosure of your personal data are made by us in the case of using of this web page or during other possible opportunities always solely in accordance with the applicable legal regulations including our internal regulations in addition thereto. We keep up with the current status of legislation in the area of the personal data protection and we update the personal data protection in our company accordingly on an ongoing basis. Then, we update these changes and additions to the rules of the personal data protection on our web pages which reflects in the changes and updates of these principles of personal data protection. Therefore, we kindly ask you to follow our principles of the personal data protection regularly. However, we intend to make all the changes to our principles of the personal data protection in order to enhance the protection of your personal data and for your comfortable contact with us.

For the purposes of communication with our customers, business partners and possibly visitors to our web pages, we only collect the personal data necessary to perform our contractual obligations or for the purposes of our best possible mutual communication and enhancement of our services or communication with the parties interested in our products and services.

For the purposes specified above, we usually collect your address (contact) personal data, i.e. your name, surname, e-mail address and telephone number. We always collect these personal data only if you yourself provide them to us. Should we need further personal data concerning you in order to meet your requirements, e.g. your interests and preferences or information on your visits to our web pages, we collect them only with your express consent. You may withdraw your consent at any time.

The personal data we collect are gathered by us to duly perform our contractual obligations, to understand better your preferences and subsequently provide better services and products to you. We use the information concerning your visits to our web pages in order to improve and develop our web pages. For this purpose, we will notify you of the changes on our web pages, in our products or services from time to time.

If you grant your consent to us, we will keep sending you information on our promotional events concerning new products, special offers, for the purposes of the market research etc.

Within the procedures allowed by legal regulations, we perform analysis of the data concerning visits to our web pages to find the purchasing trends, customer preferences, visit rate of our web pages etc. At the same, time, such information serves us to enhance the security of our web pages and security of your personal data. Information on your personal data or your activities on our web pages shall be provided by us to third parties only if the legal regulations require or allow us to do so.

Personal Data Security

Privacy protection and protection of your personal data is very important for ORGREZ a.s. We comply with all the valid regulations of European Union, Czech law and other personal data protection regulations and we deem all your information confidential. We have efficient systems of personal data protection introduced and we strive to prevent unauthorized access, loss or damage to the personal data processed or collected through us including our web pages.

Cookies

ORGREZ, a.s. does not use cookie files.

Links to Other Web Pages

Our web pages may contain links to other web pages of third parties, for instance web pages of our contractual sellers etc. Unfortunately, we do not have any control over third-party web pages and they are not subjected to our principles of the personal data protection. Their own principles of privacy protection shall apply to your personal data and they may differ from our principles. As we provide links to web pages of our respectable business partners, we are convinced that their personal data protection is sufficient. Nevertheless, should you have any questions, you should follow information on their web pages.

Your Control over the Personal Data

You may limit the processing of your personal data namely in the following manners:
a) if you provided your contact details to us, you may ask us at any time that you do not want the information provided by you to be used for the purposes of direct marketing even though we usually do not use direct marketing.

c) we will not sell, distribute or provide your personal data to third parties if we do not have your express consent or if we are not authorized to do so based on law.

d) under the conditions stipulated by legal regulations, we will provide you with more information concerning your personal data based on your request or we will transfer your personal data to the person designated by you based on your request and under the conditions stipulated by legal regulations.

e) if you expressly ask us to do so, we will delete the personal data you have provided to us in accordance with the relevant legal regulations or you may use your right to be forgotten provided it is in accordance with the relevant legal regulations.

If you think that any of your personal data we control or process are incorrect, please notify us thereof to any of the addresses specified above where you may get answers to your questions concerning the protection of your personal data, as well.
